Education in Britain is _____ for all children between the ages of 5-16. School-children attend a primary school for 6 years. When students _____ to Secondary School at the age of 11, they do not take any examination, but their reports are sent on from the Primary School.

Secondary modern school is a school for children over the age of 11, who are not expected to go on to higher study later.
