There have been many ideas for ways to care better for the environment, but not all of them have proved to be successful. Some have even damaged the environment in ways that their creators had not considered. 5

One scheme, floating cities, is something that many people still hope will solve the problem of overcrowding in our cities. ¹..... A project in China has been a little more successful in producing pollution-free islands, but they are far too expensive to copy around the world. 10

Another idea to save the planet was to use biofuels instead of traditional fuels. They're made from natural oils from plants such as palm oil and are therefore a renewable form of energy. ²..... This has led to the loss of habitat for endangered species such as tigers or rhinos. An economic consequence of this type of farming is that a global food crisis has arisen as farmers prefer to use the land for producing biofuel and not food. ³..... Despite the drawbacks of palm oil, organisations such as the World Wildlife Fund are working to help create sustainable production of this crop that does have its advantages. 15 20 25

Then, there are plastic bags. ⁴..... At the time, people were worried about using paper bags and cutting down trees, so a Swedish inventor came up with the idea of a strong reusable plastic bag. Little did he think that people would get into the habit of throwing them away after one use. ⁵..... However, in the UK, since they started charging 5p for every plastic bag, the use of bags has been reduced by more than 80%, which is amazing. It's such a straightforward idea. ⁶..... At present approximately eight million tonnes of plastic, much of which is plastic bags, goes into the world's oceans every year and is swallowed by many sea creatures. 30 35 40

Despite the failures, it's still massively important to come up with new ideas that will protect the environment. ⁷..... The domino effect of what we think are positive actions can lead to disasters. 45
