When – Apabila

Although - Walaupun

Style 1

Independent clause	Dependent clause
The children cried <i>Kanak-kanak itu menangis</i>	when the clown came. <i>apabila badut itu datang.</i>
The children cried when the clown came.	

Style 2

Dependent clause	Independent clause
When the clown came <i>Apabila badut itu datang</i>	the children cried <i>kanak-kanak itu menangis</i>
When the clown came, the children cried.
