

IF CLAUSE TYPE 0 - TYPE 1 - TYPE 2-TYPE 3

IF CLAUSE TYPE 0

We use Type 0 conditional to express scientific , general truth, etc. It is used for a situation which is always true.

Structure: IF + present simple, present simple

e.g. If you heat water at 100 degrees, it boils.

If you want to go to London, you have to get a visa.

IF CLAUSE TYPE 1 (present or future real)

We use the conditional Type 1 to describe situations which are REAL or very PROBABLE in the present and future .

Structure: (a) IF + present simple, future simple.

e.g.If you get up late, you will miss the bus.

(b) IF + present simple, S+ can/may/might/must/should + V1

e.g.If the phone rings, you can answer it.

(c) IF + present simple, imperative form(emir)

e.g. If I am late, don't wait for me.

If I am wrong , correct me.

IF CLAUSE TYPE 2 (present unreal & improbable)

We use the Conditional Type 2 to describe situations which are unreal(not possible) in the present or future.

Structure: IF + past simple, S + would/ could/might + V1 (refers NOT PAST but PRESENT)

e.g. If I had enough money, I would buy a car. (I don't have a car so I won't /can't buy a car.)

If he was/were an animal, he would be a cat.

IF CLAUSE TYPE 3 (unrealised, unreal past)-related to the past

We use the conditional Type 3 to describe situations which are unreal in the past. We can describe what would have been done differently or how something could have happened differently if circumstances had been different. We use generally to express our regrets.

Structure: IF + Past Perfect(had V3) , S + would /could/might have + V3 (past participle)

e.g.If I had had a car, I would have driven to work yesterday.

If she hadn't missed the bus, she wouldn't have missed the seminar.

(She missed the bus and seminar)
