The third person singular in the simple present tense always ends in -s:
she climbs, he runs, it rains, etc.

Let's try!



I work - He

I dance - He

I play - He

I study - He

I wash - He

CLUES FOR THE SECOND POINT!!! Go - goes Do - does Am - is - are
Have - has Can - can

I do - He

I am - He

I have - He

I can - He
