	How are you? How are things? How is it going on? How are you doing? How have you been? How is everything? (Apa kabar)	Fine, All right, Very well, Okay, (Baik) Not bad (Tidak buruk)
	I'm glad pleased happy (Saya senang bertemu dengan Anda)	Me, too.
	It's nice good great to meet you. meeting you. (Senang bertemu Anda)	It's nice good great to meet you. too. meeting you. (Senang bertemu Anda juga)
	Good morning [Diucapkan pada waktu bertemu seseorang antara pukul 00.00 sampai 11.00]	Good morning (Selamat pagi)
	Good day [Diucapkan pada waktu hendak berpisah siang hari seseorang antara pukul 12.00 sampai 14.00]	Good day (Selamat siang)
	Good afternoon [Diucapkan pada waktu bertemu seseorang antara pukul 13.00 sampai 18.00]	Good afternoon (Selamat sore)
	Good evening [Diucapkan pada waktu bertemu seseorang antara pukul 18.00 sampai 24.00]	Good evening (Selamat malam)
	Good night [Diucapkan pada waktu berpisah di malam hari]	Good night (Selamat malam)
