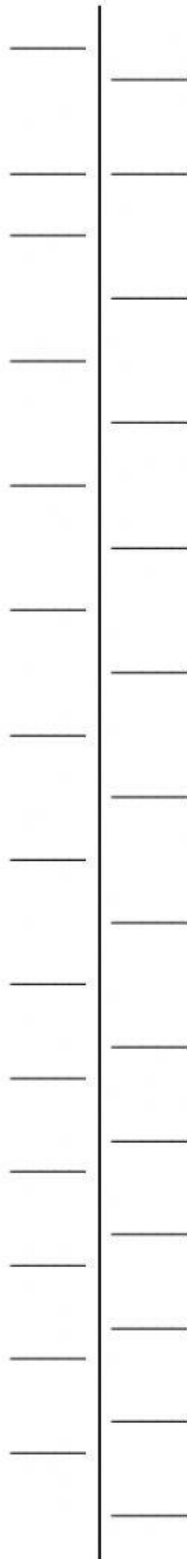

Events	Events
Christopher Columbus 1st voyage and Establishment of Hispaniola	Christopher Columbus 2nd Voyage
Portugal Sends its First African Slave ship to the Americas	Portugal Brings slaves to Europe
Vespucci's Voyage and discovery of South America, and the First Mention of "America"	Reconquista and the expulsion of Jews and Muslims from the Spanish Kingdom
Christopher Columbus 3rd Voyage and arrest for treating the Indigenous people and Colonists Brutally	King Ferdinand approves licenses for slaves in the new world
Christopher Columbus 4th and Last Voyage	St. Augustine Established as one of the oldest Cities in America (Under the spanish control at the time)
Portugal Established the first colonies in Angola and Mozambique	Martin Waldseemüller, suggested that the newly discovered world be named "from Amerigo the discovered" as if it were the land of Americus or America
