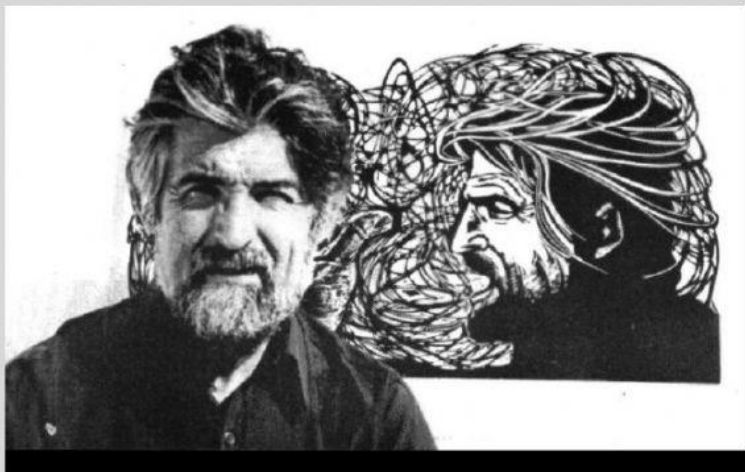


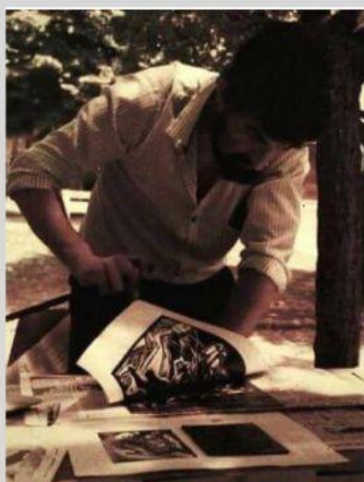

1	When and where was Adrian Giachetti born?	He used to live in San Andres, San Martin District.
2	When did he die?	He created a comic called "ATAQUE"
3	What was his nationality?	He had an extensive career in engraving (grabado). But he specialized in xylography.
4	Where did he use to live?	1 He was born on July 30 th , 1945 in BA , Argentina.
5	When did he start having contact with ART?	Actually, he was. In 1972, under the de facto government of General Alejandro Lanusse, he entered the black lists for his work "Rojo Trelew", when the authorities of that time raised an exhibition held in the Roberto Arlt square and burned everything in it. It is pertinent to note that questions about social problems are present in a large part of his production.
6	What did he do when he was at high school?	It is the art of engraving on wood or of printing from woodblocks.
7	Did he like sports?	Since he was a little kid.
8	What did he study after high school?	Yes he did. He worked at different high schools and institutions. He is well remembered for his excellent classes.
9	Did he graduate?	Yes, he did. Lot! In Argentina and abroad.
10	Did he work as a teacher and professor?	He was Argentine.
11	What did he specialize in?	Yes he did. He was a hockey goal keeper at Mitre Club.
12	What is ENGRAVING?	Yes he did. He became a professor and he also studied Sociology. So he had a bachelor's degree in sociology.
13	What is XILOGRAPHY ? /zɪ'lɒɡrəfi/	He liked Ernesto Sábato, Maio Benedetti as authors. As regards musicians he liked Carlos Gardel, Joan Manuel Serrat and Victor Heredia.
14	Was Adrian Giachetti ever in danger?	He studied FINE ARTS at "Escuela de Artes Manuel Belgrano."
15	Did he ever receive any award?	Yes, he did. He also wrote articles for different magazines and essays.
16	Did he ever write articles?	It is a technique that consists of a stamp that is produced by printing plates engraved for that purpose or it could also be defined as the art and craft by means of which molds are carved to stamp drawings and all sorts of flat letters. / Engraving is a printmaking technique that involves making incisions into a metal plate which retain the ink and form the printed image.
17	Who were his favourite authors and musicians?	He died on July 8 th , 2007. His spirit is present in his works and in the memory of those who were fortunate to know him.
