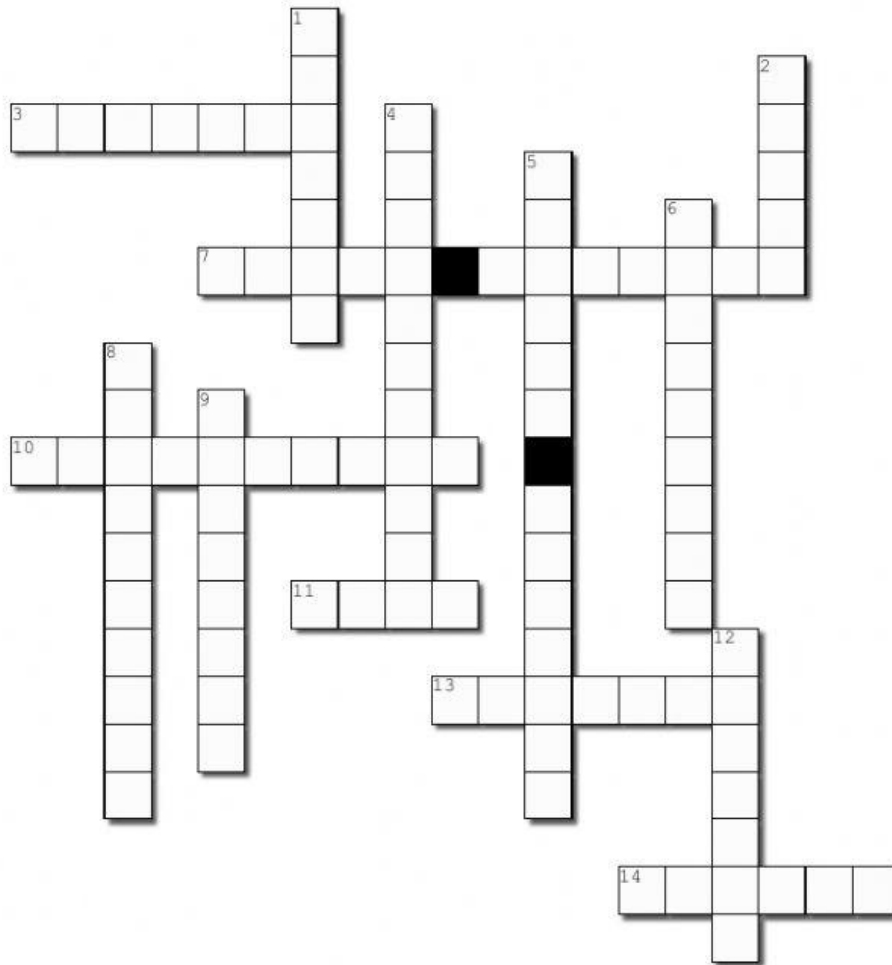


Unit 3. Renaissance
