

## Hand Stitches



### Section A True/False

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hemming Stitch is used to hold the folded edges of hems in place.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tailors tack, running stitch and basting stitches are examples of temporary stitches.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Stitches that hold the garment together, for the lifespan of the garment are called permanent stitches.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The running stitch resembles the machine stitch.
