## **The First Conditional**

First conditional is used to talk about actions/events in the future which are likely to happen or have a real possibility of happening.

## Structure:

If + Present + Subject + wil + infinitive (without to)
Simple

If it rains, I will stay at home.
 (I think there is a real possibility of rain. In this condition, I will stay at home).

- If my father doesn't buy me a bike for my birthday , I will cry a lot.
- (I think there is a real possibility that my father won't buy me a bike. In this condition, I will cry a lot).

NOTE: You can start the first conditional with the subject but don't use the comma (,) to separate any sentence:

• I will cry a lot if my father doesn't buy me a bike for my birthday.
