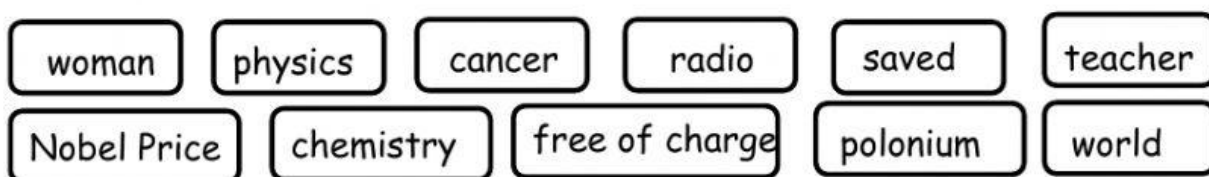


MARIE CURIE 2
