I'm going

to + infinitive (to go, to do, to send, to play, to watch, etc)

I'm going to go to the cinema = Voy a ir al cine

(to go = ir ≠ voy = I go)

I'm going to send text messages =

(to send = mandar ≠ mando = I send)

I'm going to watch tv =

(to watch = ver ≠ veo = I watch)

I'm going to go out =

(to go out = salir ≠ salgo = I go out)

I'm going to do horse riding =

(to do = hacer ≠ hago = I do)

PRESENTE + FUTURO. Translate:

I go to the cinema because I'm going to watch a film = Voy al cine porque voy a ver una película.

You go to the park because you are going to play football =

He/she goes to the shopping centre because he/she is going to go shopping =

We go to the club because we're going to dance =

You guys go to the beach because you are going to sunbathe =

(sunbathe = tomar el sol)

They go to to the bowling alley because they are going to go bowling (to go bowling = jugar a los bolos)
