

¹ able or likely to kill people (**Deadly** is specifically used with the words **poison**, **virus**, **animal** and **threat**)

² causing someone to die (*Fatal* is specifically used with events that cause death such as *accident*, *crash*, *collision* and *fall*, in situations where someone is hurt, such as *attack*, *blow*, *injury*, *shot* and *wound*, and in situations involving a very costly mistake with the words *mistake* and *error*).

Typically attacking them by kicking or trampling. Dogs: dogs kill about 30 people a year,

most often from attacks that prove fatal. Bees: bees and other stinging insects kill nearly 100 people per year, often by triggering an allergic reaction. Deer: deer cause about 1.3 million car accidents, and about 200 of them are fatal.
