

Holyrood Palace is located (1) the bottom of the Royal Mile in Edinburgh, next to Holyrood Abbey, from which it gets its name. (2) are many beautiful works of art in the palace, which can be seen by members of the public on any day of the year, (3) for 25th and 26th December. |
| | Holyrood Palace has been home to many notable kings and queens, starting (4) James II, who was born there and followed by James III, IV and V. Perhaps, though, one of the Palace's most famous residents was Mary, Queen of Scots, who lived at Holyrood House in 1561.
