5 Make *Reusable Bags* with some friends.

### You need

- bandannas or cloth squares
- yarn
- needles and thread
- hairpins

### Instructions

1. Line up two bandannas and sew around three sides.
2. Fold the remaining edge 3 cm from the top. Sew the hem, leaving an opening.
3. Attach 1 m of yarn to the hairpin.
4. Push the hairpin with the yarn through the hem.
5. Take out the hairpin and tie the yarn ends together.
6. Replace plastic bags with your reusable bags.
