Don't - Doesn't



We use **Don't** or **Doesn't** to make a **negative sentence** in the simple present tense.*

* Exceptions: Negative sentences that use *To Be* or *Modal Verbs* (can, might, etc.)

Subject		Auxiliary		Verb **
I / you / we / they	+	don't	+	go ... want ... like ...
he / she / it	+	doesn't	+	

Affirmative: You speak English.

Negative: You **don't** speak English.

Affirmative: He speaks English.

Negative: He **doesn't** speak English.

** The base form of the infinitive = **to** go, **to** need, **to** speak, **to** live
Third person verbs lose the final "s" in negative sentences.

Be careful... I ~~no~~ live in Japan. ✗I **don't** live in Japan. ✓

Affirmative: She has a cat. ✓

Negative: She **doesn't** ~~has~~ a cat. ✗Negative: She **doesn't** ~~have~~ a cat. ✓

= do not

doesn't

= does not
