TOPIC: Simile & Metaphor

Simile: A simile is a comparison of unlike objects using 'like' and 'as'.

Metaphor: A metaphor is a comparison between objects that are different from each other, without using like and as.

Examples:

1. The snow is a white blanket. (snow is being compared to a white blanket - metaphor)
2. The blanket is *as white as* snow. (the blanket is being compared to the snow – simile)
3. His face is bright like the shining star. (his face is being compared to the star – simile)
