How are you? I'm very excited. My friend Kavitha came all the way from India to visit me. Remember her from summer camp?

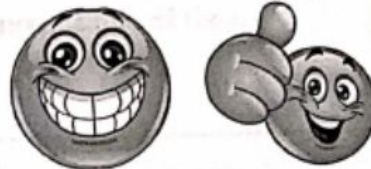
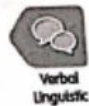
