

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CONJUNCTIONS AND-BUT

*Conjunction is a word that joins words, phrases, clauses or sentences.
Examples: but, and, yet, because*

CONJUNCTIONS

- Use *and* for additional information:

The food is delicious, **and** it's not expensive.

- Use *but, though, and however* for contrasting information:

The food is delicious, **but** it's very expensive.

and

links
similar (or like)
ideas

*I like apples
and
bananas.*

but

links
contrasting
ideas

*I like apples
but
I don't like bananas.*
