Conjunction is a word that joins words, phrases, clauses or sentences.
Examples: **but**, **and**, **yet**, **because**

CONJUNCTIONS

- Use **and** for additional information:

The food is delicious, **and** it's not expensive.

- Use **but**, **though**, and **however** for contrasting information:

The food is delicious, **but** it's very expensive.

I don't like bananas.*
