## *Past Continuous Tense + Simple Past Tense*

### *When / While*

We often use the Past Continuous tense with the Simple Past tense.

We use the *Past continuous tense* to express a *long action*. And we use the *Simple Past tense* to express a *short action* that happens in the middle of the long action. We can join the two ideas with **when or while**.

**when** + short action (simple past tense) : **the telephone rang**

**When the telephone rang, I was sleeping.**

**while** + long action (past continuous tense): **I was sleeping**

**While I was sleeping, the telephone rang.**

There are 4 basic combinations:

	PAST CONTINUOUS	<b>when</b>	PAST SIMPLE.
<b>When</b>	PAST SIMPLE	,	PAST CONTINUOUS
	PAST SIMPLE	<b>while</b>	PAST CONTINUOUS
<b>While</b>	PAST CONTINUOUS	,	PAST SIMPLE

#### Parallel actions in the past

When you use the **Past Continuous** with two actions in the same sentence, it expresses the idea that *both actions were happening at the same time*. The actions are parallel

**WHILE** Past Continuous , Past Continuous

Past Continuous **WHILE** past continuous

	The car exploded	while	I was walking on the street
While	I was walking on the street	,	it exploded.

While	Ellen <u>was reading</u>	,	Tim <u>was watching television.</u>
	<u>Were you listening</u>	while	<u>he was talking?</u>
