To make a wish about the present, use:

wish + simple past

Examples:

I can't visit my friends in Spain.

I don't have time to exercise.

We are sick.

These sweaters are expensive.

I wish I had time to exercise.

I wish we weren't sick.

I wish they were cheaper.
