


Verb TO Be ser o estar **Affirmative:**

You (tú)	are (eres o estás)	're (eres o estás)
He (él)	is (es o está)	's (es o está)
She (ella)	is (es o está)	's (es o está)
It (ella/o, para animales o cosas)	is (es o está)	's (es o está)
We	are (somos o estamos)	're (somos o estamos)
You	are (sois o estáis)	're (sois o estáis)
They	are (son o están)	're (son o están)
