The Devil's Sea, also known as the Dragon's Triangle, is located in the Pacific off the southern coast of Japan. Unexplained phenomena, including mysterious disappearances, have occurred in this area. A story claims that in the early '50s, five military ships carrying more than 700 sailors were lost in the Triangle. The ships, like many fishing boats, simply vanished without a trace, and the Japanese government declared the area a danger zone. Some people suggested that the region's volcanic activity could have been the cause of the disappearances. However, recent investigations have determined that the loss of the ships was due to bad weather conditions and piracy, rather than to any supernatural activity.

The Superstition Mountains are a mountain range located in eastern Arizona. According to the legend, in the 1800s, a man named Jacob Waltz discovered a huge gold mine in the mountains that later became known as the *Lost Dutchman's*

Gold Mine. Waltz kept the location a secret until the day he died. After many expeditions, the mine has never been found. Some say the ghosts of those who lost their lives in search of the Dutchman's gold still haunt the mountains. Others say that the zone is guarded by creatures that live under the mountains in caves and tunnels.

The Michigan Triangle is located in Lake Michigan in the north of the US. The Triangle has been blamed for the mysterious disappearances of ships' crew members and airplanes. In 1937, the unexplained disappearance of Captain George Donner gave the area a reputation of being a strange very place. One day, Donner gave his crew orders to wake him up when the ship got into port. But when they went to his cabin three hours later, Donner had vanished. There was no logical explanation, since Donner's cabin door was locked from the inside!
