<ul> <li>Regular verbs form their past and past participle forms by adding –ed.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Irregular verbs form their past and past participle forms in different ways.</li> </ul>	
There are mainly rules of regular verbs	There are mainly three types of irregular verbs:

If a verb ends in -e, add -d.	Verbs in which all the three forms are the	noviembre 2021
<ul> <li>like → liked</li> <li>arrive → arrived</li> <li>decide → decided</li> </ul>	same (e.g. put – put – put)  Type # 2	2021
Rule #2		
If a verb ends in consonant + -y, change - y to -i and add -ed.	Verbs in which two of the three forms are the same (e.g. sit – sat – sat)	
<ul> <li>carry → carried</li> <li>try → tried</li> <li>study → studied</li> </ul>	Type # 3	
Rule #3		
If a verb ends in vowel + -y, add -ed.*	Verbs in which all three forms are different (e.g. drink – drank – drunk)	
<ul> <li>play → played</li> <li>stay → stayed</li> <li>enjoy → enjoyed</li> </ul>		



#### Rule #4

If a verb ends in a consonant-vowelconsonant (CVC) pattern, double the final consonant and add -ed.\*\*

- hug → hugged
- $plan \rightarrow planned$
- $stop \rightarrow stopped$

#### Rule #5

For all other verbs, add -ed.

- watch → watched
- ask → asked
- clean → cleaned

#### Some verbs can be both regular and irregular.

Burn - burnt - burnt (irregular)

Burn - burned - burned (regular)

Dream - dreamt - dreamt (irregular)

Dream - dreamed - dreamed (regular)

Lean - lent - lent (irregular)

Lean - leaned - leaned (regular)

Learn - learnt - learnt (irregular)

Learn - learned - learned (regular)

Leap - leapt - leapt (irregular)

Leap - leaped - leaped (regular)

Smell – smelt – smelt (irregular)

Smell - smelled - smelled (regular)

Spill - spilt - spilt (irregular)

Spill - spilled - spilled (regular)

Spoil - spoilt - spoilt (irregular)

Spoil - spoiled - spoiled (regular)
