If you are interested in art **The Louvre Museum** is the place for you. It is the biggest art museum in the world and a historic monument in Paris, France. It is also the most visited museum. 9.6 million people visited The Louvre in 2019.

When the museum opened in 1793 there were 537 paintings. Now you can see 38,000 objects from prehistory to the 21st century.

Next year I am going to visit The Louvre with my best friend to celebrate our 15th birthday.

Do you like History? I love it. Last year our History teacher took our class to the **MAPI** (Museo de Arte Precolombino e Indígena) in the old city, Montevideo. It was fantastic. It opened in 2004.
