

SIMPLE PAST VS. PAST CONTINUOUS

Past continuous

Example:

1 At the time of the crash, Carl was going (go) to work.

2 He (drink) coffee.

3 He (send) a text.

4 He (not look) at the road.

Past simple

5 Carl (not see) the stop sign.

6 Luckily, he (get) better quickly after the accident!

7 He never (use) his phone again while he was driving.
