- Identify the tense of the text
- Answers do not stray from the category of the error
 - ★ Article - a, an the
 - ★ 'Be' verb - am, is, are / was, were
 - ★ To infinitive - to 'play' (the verb after 'to' need to be in base form)
 - ★ Conjunction - and, but, or
 - ★ Adjective and adverb
 - ★ Personal pronouns - I, he, she, they, we / him, her, them, us, me
 - ★ Preposition - in, on, at
 - ★ 'Have' verb - has, have
 - ★ Modal + verb
 - ★ Singular and plural nouns
