The US retail giant Amazon _____ pressure in Germany, the company's biggest market outside the US.

Trade union Verdi called on workers at seven German Amazon warehouses to go on a three-day strike. However, the strike would **coincide** with 'Black Friday' discount shopping sales on November 27. The strike is scheduled to begin with Wednesday's night shift, with Verdi demanding better pay and working conditions. Verdi has been organizing strikes at Amazon Germany since 2013.
