Now reply to Alex's email.

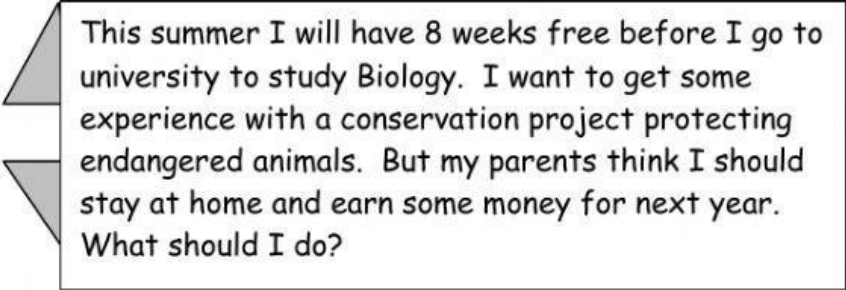
