A, AN, SOME, ANY

We use **A** or **AN** with singular nouns.

A is used when a noun starts

with a consonant sound;
e.g. A dog, a book, etc.
AN is used when a noun
starts with a vowel sound;

e.g. An apple, an hour, etc.

We use SOME with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns.

SOME is used in:

- * positive sentences;
- e.g. I have some time.
- * questions, expressing requests and offers;

E.g. Would you like some coffee?

Can I have some biscuits?

We use **ANY** with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns.

ANY is used in:

- * negative sentences;
- e.g. I don't have any time.
- * general questions;
- e.g. Do you have any sisters?
