# PAST SIMPLE

\*Eventos del pasado.

We use the past simple tense to talk about events in the past.

### REGULAR VERBS

We follow rules to form the past of regular verbs. All of them are formed equally.

\*El pasado de los verbos regulares se forma igual para todos siguiendo unas reglas.

#### IRREGULAR VERBS

Each verb is different. There isn't a rule for all of them. You have to memorize them (only afirmative).

\*Cada verbo irregular se forma de manera diferente. Existe una lista de verbos irregulares que hay que memorizar (solo en afirmativa, en negativa e interrogativa es igual que los regulares)

## >>> REGULAR VERBS (

To make the past simple of regular verbs we add **-ed** to the verb.

Play - Played You played football (Tu jugaste a fútbol)


\*Para formar el pasado de verbos regulare se añade -ed

#### **Rules:**

- For regular verbs that end in "e" we add -d. Ex: live lived
- For regular verbs that end in "y" and has a consonant before it, we change "y" to "i" and add -ed. Ex: try tried
- For regular verbs that end in consonant, vowel, consonant, we **double** the final consonant and add **-ed.** *Ex: Stop Stopped*
- To make the negative we use **did not** or **didn't**. **Subjet + did + not + verb -** She **didn't** play tennis \*Cuando usamos el "**did"** desaparece el -**ed**
- ? To make the interrogative we use **did.**\*Todos los sujetos se forman igual (I,You, She, They...)
