Phrasal verbs with get

Examples:

Get off (somewhere) → I got off work early because I was really tired.

Get out of (doing something) → I got out of cleaning the bathroom because I don't like to do it.

Get it → A: Do you have any questions? B: No. Now I get it.

Get over something → I got over my last relationship.

Get going → We have to get going or we will be late!

Get away with something → In some schools, students can get away with wearing jeans as uniform.

Get used to → I'm getting used to come to school after 2 years.

Get through → After the last difficult situation I got through, now, it is easier for me to think positively.

Get to know → I'm getting to know my new classmates.

Get around to do something → I'm getting around to studying for my English test.

Get the feeling → I get the feeling that your cat doesn't like me.
