| 6. prescription label | medicine that is applied or rubbed onto skin |
| 7. pharmacy | tells whom the medication is for and how it should be taken |
| 8. apply | to fill again after all the medication is gone |
| 9. capsule | a small flat medication that is taken by mouth |
| 10. pharmacist | a common small spoon that is used to measure (abbreviated t. or tsp.) |
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
