



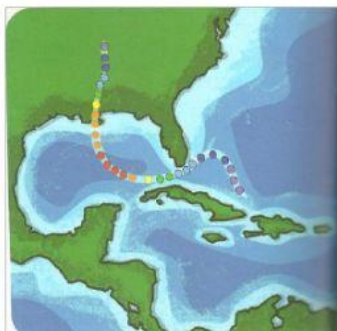

2005 ATLANTIC HURRICANE SEASON



Hurricane Katrina was one of the strongest Atlantic hurricanes ever recorded. Everyone knew it was coming, but were they ready for it?

Katrina formed on 23rd August during the 2005 hurricane season. For days, the media was warning people that a terrible storm was on its way, but despite the warnings, at least 1,836 people lost their lives and 705 were not found. The storm caused approximately US\$81.2 billion in damage, without considering the costs of repairs. The Bahamas, Cuba, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama and most of eastern North America suffered and 80% of New Orleans was flooded.

Everyone knew that Katrina was coming. By the morning of 28th August it was a Category 5 hurricane with winds of 160 km. As the storm increased, people were terribly worried. Unfortunately, there was no public transport; so many people could not leave the area! On 28th August, Ray Nagin, Mayor of New Orleans, declared a mandatory evacuation of the city but it was too late!
