

## Present Simple

When the subject of the sentence is **He**, **She**, or **It**, we add an "s" to the end of the verb. When the subject is **I**, **You**, **We**, or **They**, we do not add an "s" to the end of the verb.

Example: **He** plays basketball.

**I** play basketball.
