When the subject of the sentence is He, She, or It, we add an "s" to
the end of the verb. When the subject is ${f I}$ , ${f You}$ , ${f We}$ , or ${f They}$ , we
do not add an "s" to the end of the verb.

Example: **He** play<u>s</u> basketball.
