PRESENT SIMPLE (am/is/are + past participle)

1. I study English at school.
2. I change money at the bank.
3. I eat chocolate in the morning.
4. I buy flowers in that shop.
5. I water the garden every weekend.
6. I clean my room in the afternoon.
7. I teach French at the Secondary School.
8. I wash the dishes on Monday.
9. I do my homework every day.
10. I phone my grandmother every day.



PRESENT CONTINUOUS (am/is/are +being+ past participle)

1. They are drinking coke.
2. They are listening to music.
3. They are eating meat today.
4. I am writing a letter to you.
5. He is selling vegetables.
6. She is doing the homework.
7. We are Reading the Celestina.
8. My brother is studying Music.
9. She is opening doors.
10. I am watching television at the moment.



PAST SIMPLE (was/were + past participle)

1. I bought something to eat.
2. He threw the ball to me.
3. We needed some money.
4. I wore my new dress yesterday.
5. They lost the ticket at the station.
6. I sent a letter to Maria.
7. We sold old coins.
8. I cooked a cake yesterday.
9. I failed seven subjects last term.
