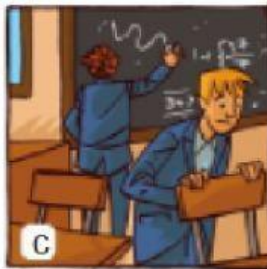

At Summer High, there are 172 rules and punishments, for example: pupils don't have to wear a uniform, they can't use mobile phones in class, there's no homework to do, and so on. They have to do household tasks

(for example, tidy the classrooms or wash the dishes). And here are some of the punishments: pupils have to stay behind after school, do extra writing, apologise etc.

Summer High believes that we should let children take decisions and risks. Children shouldn't just listen: they should ask questions, too. Summer High also believes pupils should do well at school because in this way they can be successful and happy.

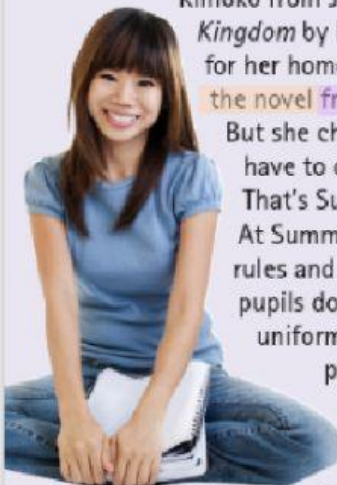

'Yes, because it made me enjoy learning. **I didn't have to learn: I chose to!**'
