MOUTH

In our MOUTH we chew food and mix it with saliva to make it easier to swallow and digest.

- chew: masticar
- mix: mezclar
- easier: más fácil
- swallow: tragar
- digest: digerir

ESOPHAGUS

Then food goes down the ESOPHAGUS into the STOMACH.

- down: abajo

STOMACH

In the STOMACH, some liquids break down food into nutrients.

- break down: descomponen

LIVER

The LIVER produces one of these liquids called bile.

- liquids: líquidos
- bile: bilis

SMALL INTESTINE

In the SMALL INTESTINE nutrients are absorbed by our body.

- absorbed: absorvidos

LARGE INTESTINE

The food our body doesn't need goes to the LARGE INTESTINE and it leaves the body as a waste.

- leaves: abandona
- waste: desecho
