When talking about the third person singular (he, she, it) we add a SUPER S / ES / IES

Use to talk about routines, habits or general truths.

Used when we talk about something that happened and ended in the past.

Used when talking about our plans for the future.

Used when talking about what we are doing right now and temporary actions

It's structure is: verb to BE + GOING TO + verb

It's structure is: verb to BE + verb + ING

We use regular verbs (-ED) or irregular ones.
