We ask yes/no questions in the past simple by starting with **was, were** or **did**.

Questions		
Was	I/ he/ she/ it	happy?
Were	you/ we/ they	

Short answers
☺ Yes, I/ he/she/ it was .
☹ No, I/ he/she/ it wasn't .
☺ Yes, you/ we/ they were .
☹ No, you/ we/ they weren't .

Questions		
Did	I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they	sleep?

Short answers
☺ Yes, I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they did .
☹ No, I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they didn't .



Did you go to school yesterday?

- Yes, I **did**.

Did you go with your friends?

- No, I **didn't**.



Were you at school yesterday?

- Yes, I **was**.

Were you late for school?

- No, I **wasn't**.
