**PAST SIMPLE: YES/ NO QUESTIONS**

We ask yes/no questions in the past simple by starting with **was, were** or **did**.

Questions		
Was	I/ he/ she/ it	happy?
Were	you/ we/ they	

Short answers
☺ Yes, I/ he/she/ it <b>was</b> .
☹ No, I/ he/she/ it <b>wasn't</b> .
☺ Yes, you/ we/ they <b>were</b> .
☹ No, you/ we/ they <b>weren't</b> .

Questions		
Did	I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they	sleep?

Short answers
☺ Yes, I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they <b>did</b> .
☹ No, I/ he/she/ it/ you/ we/ they <b>didn't</b> .



**Did** you go to school yesterday?

- Yes, I **did**.

**Did** you go with your friends?

- No, I **didn't**.

**Were** you at school yesterday?

- Yes, I **was**.

**Were** you late for school?

- No, I **wasn't**.
