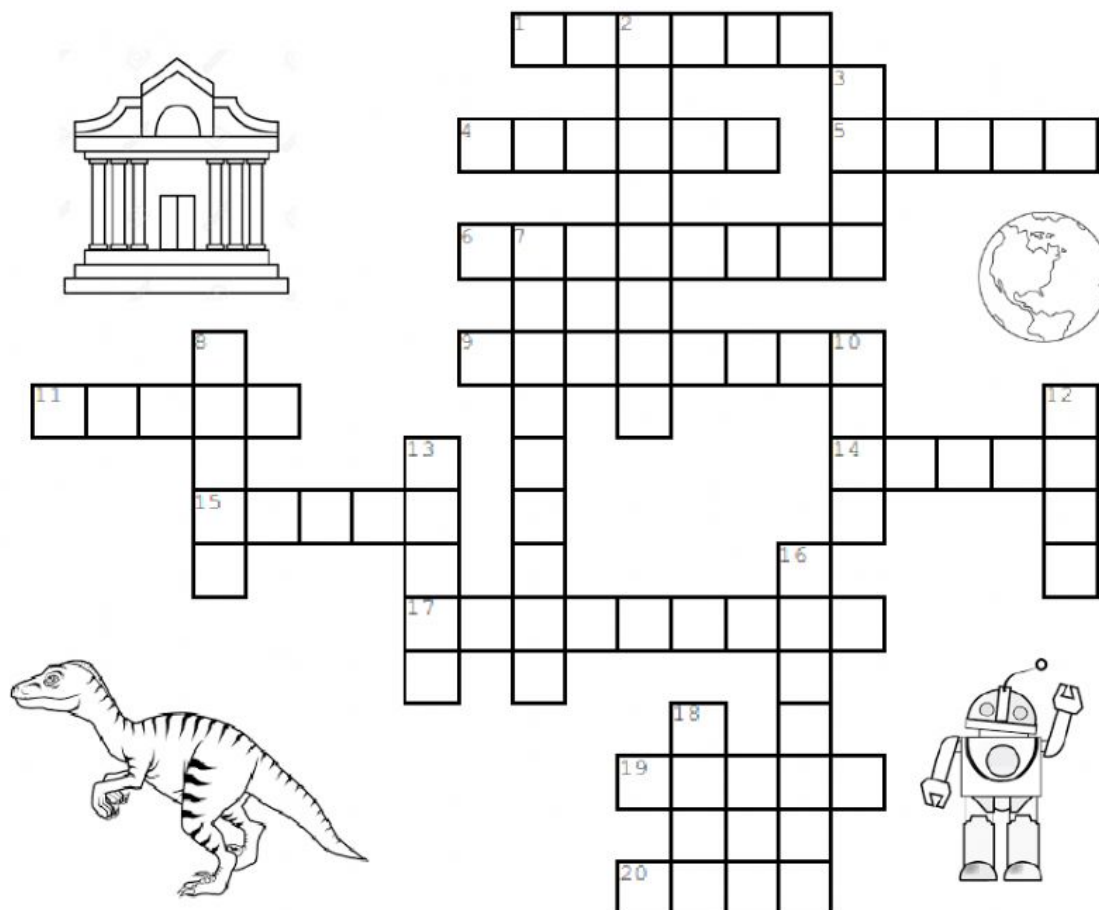

Millions of years ago, long before there were any people, there were more than 700 different types of _____. Some dinosaurs were _____ and others were really small. The largest dinosaurs were over 30 meters long and up to 15 meters tall (e.g. diplodocus, brachiosaurus). The smallest dinosaurs were about the size of a chicken.

Some dinosaurs ate plants – they are called *herbivores*. Some could fly and others lived in the sea. Dinosaurs that ate meat are called *carnivores*. Some walked on two legs and others walked on four legs. Those who walked on two legs (e.g. Tyrannosaurus Rex) could move very _____, but those that walked on four legs were usually big and heavy, so they were much slower (e.g. stegosaurus).

We know they were all different, but no one knows what colour or _____ they were. This is because there is no dinosaur _____ left to study.

How did dinosaurs _____? Some _____ think that a large rock called an _____ fell to Earth from space. This made the Earth colder and there was no more food for dinosaurs to eat.
