Remember

/əʊ/

➤ “ou” phát âm là /əʊ/ trong những từ có nhóm “ou” với một hay hai phụ âm

- around /ə'raʊnd/: xung quanh, vòng quanh
- county /'kaʊnti/: hạt, tỉnh
- sound /saʊnd/: âm thanh

➤ “ow” phát âm là /əʊ/

- power /paʊə(r)/: sức mạnh, quyền lực
- powder /'paʊdə(r)/: bột, thuốc bột
- crown /kraʊn/: vương miện

/əʊ/

➤ “oa” được phát âm là /əʊ/ trong một từ có một âm tiết tận cùng bằng một hay hai phụ âm

- coat /kəʊt/: áo choàng
- road /rəʊd/: con đường

➤ “ow” được phát âm là /əʊ/

- know /nəʊ/: biết
- slow /sləʊ/: chậm

➤ “O” thường được phát âm là /əʊ/ khi nó ở cuối một từ

- go /gəʊ/: đi
- no /nəʊ/: không

➤ “ou” có thể được phát âm là /əʊ/

- soul /səʊl/: tâm hồn
- dough /dəʊ/: bột nhão
