We use superlative adjectives to compare one thing or person to lots of other things or people.

	Adjective	+ superlative	- superlative
Regular adjectives	mean	the <b>meanest</b>	the <b>least</b> mean
Two syllable adjectives ending in -y	happy	the <b>happiest</b>	the <b>least</b> happy
Two or more syllable adjectives	interesting	the <b>most</b> interesting	the <b>least</b> interesting
Irregular adjectives	good bad	the best the worse	-
