## Superlatives with **-est** and **most**

I'm	<b>the</b>	<b>shortest</b>	student	in my class.
He's		<b>tallest</b>	actor	on TV.
She's		<b>funniest</b>	person	I know.
It's		<b>most popular</b>	food	on the menu.
They're		<b>most famous</b>	football players	in the world.

One syllable: *short* → **the shortest**   *tall* → **the tallest**

Two syllables ending in *y*: *funny* → **the funniest**

Two or more syllables: *famous* → **the most famous**   *popular* → **the most popular**
