People who work with wildlife: Dev Singh

Dev Singh lives in Sri Lanka, is an island country in South Asia. He works for an organisation that protects elephants.

Looking for wild elephants is the most dangerous part of his job – the team have to be very careful when they find one. 'Once I saw an elephant and I thought it was sleeping. But I realised it wasn't asleep when it suddenly got up and ran after me! '

Dev works all day looking after the elephants. A lot of the time, he works at his computer, writing reports or entries for his blog. There are also a lot of visitors. Dev shows them the elephants and explains his team's work.

Even after his dinner, his work doesn't stop. He goes out to the fields to take photographs and make notes about them. 'It's a very long day but I enjoy every minute of it. I love being with the elephants and I love my job.'
