Long ago some people believed that the Earth was flat. However, others thought that the Earth might be round. Christopher Columbus was one of them. He wanted to find a shorter route to India. He thought that he could find it by sailing west. He decided to talk the king and queen of Spain into paying for his trip. They hoped that Christopher Columbus would bring back species and other riches from India.

Columbus and his crew were prepared to travel on August 3rd, 1492. They were provided with three ships: "Niña", "Pinta" and "Santa María". They sailed during weeks. After about two months, they found land. Columbus thought they were in Asia. But they were really on an island in the Bahamas.

Columbus continued to sail on to Cuba. He wanted to explore a world that was new to Europeans. This would later be called the "New World". Native American people lived in the islands. Columbus called them "Indians", because he thought they had landed in the Indies, also known as Asia. At first, the Indians were happy to see their visitors. Columbus gave them cheap presents and bells, but he also claimed their island for Spain! When Columbus returned to Spain, the king and queen were happy with him.
